

Science: Health & Movement. This term we will be finding out what a healthy, balanced diet looks like. We will be investigating which foods different animals eat and exploring human and animal skeletons. We will also be finding out the functions of the skeleton and muscles. In the 2nd half term we will be studying animals including humans. We will be describing the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans, identifying the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions, construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.

The children will be discussing the question, 'What do Hindus believe that God is like?' This will involve looking at the aum symbol; identifying some Hindu deities and say how they help Hindus describe god; making links between the story of Diwali and what Hindus believe about God.

As we move into the second half term we will be answering the question "What is the Trinity?" in Christianity.

Geography:

2nd half term – Out of Africa

Comparing biomes, vegetation and human geography of Kenya with Devon.

Identifying the continents.

English: Our class book this half term will be 'Arthur and the Golden Rope' by Joe Todd Stanton. This is an adventure quest story. The children will be writing an alternative ending to the story followed by a character wanted poster about the Viking wolf Fenrir.

The second half term we will be studying Zoo by Anthony Browne which will tie in with our geography unit on Kenya. The children will write a persuasive letter based on the book, plus information texts.
