**Teaching sequence for Complete comprehension:**

**Monday-Get ready**

- Introduce key vocabulary for your text.
- Use vocabulary discussion questions to explore words in context, looking at synonyms and antonyms.
- Use get ready questions to explore children's exiting knowledge of genre/subject

**Tuesday-First steps**

- Read the comprehension text
- First step questions (explore the basic outline of the passage)

**Wednesday-Skills focus**

- Introduce skill focus using skills guide
- Model the target skill (use modelling slides)
- Practise the target skill (let's try questions)

**Thursday –Practise (range of comprehension skills)**

- Mix it up! Questions
- Recognise questions from different skill areas.

**Friday-Topic based guided reading**

- Explore vocabulary/texts linked to class topic (literacy shed is a good place to start for topic themed guided reading extracts).

**Progress checks-completed termly (except for year 1, complete x3 progress checks at the end of the year)**

- Work independently
- Not timed
- Provide a snap shot of pupils' comprehension
