

History/Geography:

1st half term

Year 5 will be working on projects linked to UK coastlines and rivers. They will consider how humans have changed the coastline? How our coastline is protected. Environmental impacts on our coastlines

2nd half term

How do we know so much about the Greeks? Explore a range of sources for clues to everyday life and beliefs. Look at the legacy of some of ancient Greek "Big Ideas" and achievements and their influence on the western world. Where in the world is Greece? Locate Greece on a world map and globes. Describe its features. Use this knowledge to create sketch maps showing the humans and physical features of Greece.

ICT:

1st half term – Flat-file databases - Using a database to order data and create charts to answer questions.

2nd half term - Introduction to spreadsheets - Answering questions by using spreadsheets to organise and calculate data.

1st half term- We will be focussing on the reading, grammar, punctuation and spelling ready for the Y6 SATs. Y6 will also be preparing for their SATs writing assessments, focussing on Coastlines for some cross curricular writing. In addition, we will be using Anne-Marie Allen's book about sea pollution 'Breaker' to inspire some narrative and persuasive writing.

1st half term – coastal paper art

Science:

1st half term- Living things and their habitats

Describe how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including microorganisms, plants and animals .

Give reasons for classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics.

2nd half term- Animals including humans

describe the changes as humans develop to old age.

Pupils should draw a timeline to indicate stages in the growth and development of humans.

They should learn about the changes experienced in puberty.

Pupils could work scientifically by researching the gestation periods of other animals and comparing them with humans; by finding out and recording the length and mass of a baby as it grows (RSA/PSHE link)
